Teachers and chaperones are responsible for establishing and monitoring expectations with these water features.

Ground Rules

- 1. Respect the plants, animals, and one another so that we all succeed.
- When guides are teaching, listen with open ears to hear things you want to know.
- 3. Let the guide lead us and stay with the group so we have more time for learning and fun.
- 4. As we explore with our senses, we'll leave things where they are for others to enjoy too.
- 5. Use quiet voices inside the building as not to disturb others.

Guidelines for Teachers and Chaperones

- 1. Teachers and adult chaperones are responsible for supervising their groups, which includes discipline and first aid as needed.
- 2. Please remember that the field trip is for the students:
 - a. Avoid chatting with the other adults; it can be distracting for everyone and makes it difficult for the students to hear what the guide is saying.
 - b. Let the students answer the questions. Any personal gardening questions should be saved for the end of the field trip.
 - c. Turn off or silence cell phones during the field trip.
 - d. Make alternate arrangements for younger children who are not part of the group.
- 3. Make sure that all adults and students follow the Ground Rules so guides can focus on teaching.
